IDN REGISTRATION POLICY

IDN registration will be provided in Spanish language.

* Allowed characters are numbers “0” to “9”, hyphen “-”, all letters from “a” to “z” and the following special characters from Spanish language: á, é, í, ó, ú, ü, ñ.

When registering a domain name there will be an extra availability check for an equivalent domain name or variant.

In detail

An IDN is a domain name that incorporates at least one of the special characters from Spanish language (á, é, í, ó, ú, ü, ñ) listed in the .LAT IDN table. For example, the following domain names are IDNs: méxico.lat, méxico.lat, méxico.lat, méxico.lat, méxico.lat, méxico.lat and méxico.lat. A base domain is a domain name that uses one or more of the characters that have variant relations in the .LAT IDN table. For example, the domain name méxico.lat, if registered, will be the base domain for its variant domain names: méxico.lat, méxico.lat, méxico.lat, méxico.lat, méxico.lat and méxico.lat.

If a base domain exists, registration of its variant domain names will not be permitted.

If the registrar uses LAT IDN EPP Extension the SRS will respond to a domain:check command including the base domain when the queried domain object has not been created but the base domain exists.
