

**.LAT Reserved Domain Names Policy**  
Policies Effective since January 30, 2015.

Domain names that are within the following categories, are reserved, therefore, they may not be registered under the .LAT gTLD.

**1. Domain Names reserved by ICANN:** in accordance with Specification 5 (five) of the Registry Agreement:

- 1.1. The “example” label.
- 1.2. All the two characters labels.
- 1.3. Labels related to the operation of the Registry: www, rdds, whois, nic
- 1.4. Names of countries and territories contained in internationally recognized lists:
  - 1.4.1. ISO 3133-1 Short form, including the European Union.
  - 1.4.2. The technical reference manual for the standardization of geographical names.
  - 1.4.3. The list of the countries members of the United Nations in the 6 (six) official languages.
  - 1.4.4. Words reserved by the International Olympic Committee and the International Red Cross and the Red Crescent Movement.
  - 1.4.5. Intergovernmental Organizations as specified by ICANN and published in: <http://www.icann.org/en/resources/registries/reserved>

**2. Domain Names reserved by .LAT Registry’s internal policies:**

- 2.1. Domain Names related to the structure and functions of ICANN.
- 2.2. Domain Names related to the structure and functions of IANA.
- 2.3. Common Domain Names related to technical aspects of the Internet.
- 2.4. Domain Names reserved for the use concerning the operation and promotion of Registry LAT.
